Re: Spadra Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency – Notice of Public Meeting

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Spadra Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) will hold an initial public meeting to discuss the preparation of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the Spadra Basin pursuant to the California Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014 (SGMA) and to solicit public stakeholder engagement for the process. Interested parties may, and are encouraged to, participate in the development and implementation of the GSP by attending this initial meeting and becoming involved in the advisory committee that will be formed in relation to the preparation of the GSP. That advisory committee will meet periodically as the development of the GSP proceeds.

BACKGROUND

The SGMA requires the formation of GSAs to oversee California's groundwater basins and to implement GSPs for those basins. The Walnut Valley Water District and the City of Pomona have formed the Spadra Basin GSA pursuant to a Memorandum of Agreement in accordance with SGMA to manage the Spadra Basin's groundwater resources. The GSA is in the beginning stages of developing a GSP for the Spadra Basin. This is the first public meeting to kickoff stakeholder education and engagement for the process of developing the GSP for the Spadra Basin.
