A copy was posted on the Spadra Basin website and was emailed to potential stakeholders and interested parties prior to that meeting. Comments on TM1 were due to staff by December 3, 2019.

A brief discussion was held on comments submitted by the State of California Department of Fish and Wildlife, and the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster. Mr. Teuber noted that Wildermuth will incorporate the comments in a redline version of TM1 for review by both the Executive Committee and the Advisory Committee. He also noted that a draft of Technical Memorandum No. 2 will be presented to both committees sometime in March or April.
